



### Direct Draft Card

If you wish to pay your monthly service by direct draft, please fill out the card at right and return with a voided check. **Remember, you will now be charged a \$2.00 fee for receiving a paper bill. Please avoid this additional charge by signing up for direct draft today!!** Your account will be drafted on or after the 5th of each month. A "test" draft will be activated for the first month to ensure accuracy, therefore, you will receive one more statement for that month to be paid by check or money order. Thereafter, all monthly payments will be direct drafted from the account specified by you.



### Saving on Food Costs

With today's economy, it pays to be budget conscious. There are many ways to save money on your weekly grocery bill.

Some ideas include:

- **Buy what is on sale, not what you feel like eating today.** You may feel like eating it tomorrow.
- **Buy the family pack, even if you are just one person.** Boneless skinless chicken breasts may be \$3.49/lb for two pieces, but in a 10lb pack they go for \$1.99/lb. Separate the order into one-serving sized freezer zip bags, or split the order with a friend. Shop with your friend and save.

- **Buy store brands.** They are usually as good as well-known brands, and are often made by a brand you recognize. So compare for yourself. In fact, some store brands, also known as private-label brands, are produced by the same big-name companies churning out the products you know and love.
- **Shop at dollar stores.** They are everywhere now. Only do this if you can resist the temptation to load up the cart with things you don't need. Otherwise the savings on cleaning products, toothbrushes, some house wares and a

few foods can add up.

- **When picking out products, always remember to scan the bottom and top shelves.** The products the store makes the most money on -- which usually means the more expensive ones -- are chest-high, where they are easy to see and reach. You will save money!
- **Plan a weekly menu based on the store circulars so that you don't have to go to the supermarket as frequently,** and you can buy what is on sale that week.
